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TOP VALUES-DOMESTIC WINES

Wow! Readers should be buying these two terrific values from Buehler Vineyards by the case. The **2009 Chardonnay Russian River** is a steal. Fresh honeysuckle notes intermixed with pineapple and white peach nuances merge from this medium-bodied effort. There is not a hint of oak in this beauty, only a luscious texture, good freshness and crisp acids. Enjoy it over the next 1-2 years.

A real steal and one of the greatest sleepers I have tasted from Napa (the Mecca for expensive cabernet sauvignons) is Buehler's **2008 Cabernet Sauvignon** from their vineyards in Napa Valley... It offers a dark ruby/purple-tinged color, abundant black currant, licorice and smoky tobacco leaf characteristics, medium to full body, a supple, velvety style and impressive purity, texture and length. Consume over the next 10+ years.
